Zýmē Valpolicella DOP Classico Superiore 2011

91 points

“Abundantly aromatic, with a range of herbes de Provence, dried tea rose, bergamot and spice leading the way, accenting flavors of plump cherry and fresh, loamy earth. Finely knit and mouthwatering, with a lasting, lightly chewy finish. Drink now through 2025. 70 cases imported.” –AN

Zýmē 60-20-20 Cabernet IGP Veneto Rosso 2010

“A rich red, with medicinal herb, spice and melted licorice accents to the flavors of crème de cassis, graphite, chocolate-covered cherry and smoky mineral. Supple and well-knit, featuring good aromatics on the lasting, chewy finish. Drink now through 2025. 80 cases imported.” –AN

Zýmē Oselata IGP Provincia di Verona 2009

“Inviting wild cherry, floral and herb notes are framed by dense, fine-grained tannins in this medium- to full-bodied red. Bright and juicy, with mineral, black licorice and additional cherry flavors on the firm, lasting finish. Should open nicely with some short-term cellaring. Best from 2017 through 2025. 50 cases imported.” –AN

Zýmē Amarone della Valpolicella DOP Classico 2008

“Medicinal herb and spice notes waft through the nose and silky palate of this elegant red, accenting flavors of sun-dried cherry, red currant pâte de fruit, ganache, graphite and fig bread. The fine-grained tannins are supple and well-knit, firming on the lasting, spiced finish. Drink now through 2030. 150 cases imported.” –AN

Zýmē Amarone della Valpolicella DOP Classico Riserva

“La Mattonara” 2003

“Long and silky, this harmonious red offers fine-grained tannins swathed in flavors of ripe black cherry puree, raspberry ganache, tarry smoke, coffee liqueur and Asian five-spice powder. Dense and focused, with a persistent finish. Drink now through 2033.” –AN
