Chambolle-Musigny 1er Cru Les Sentiers





Les Sentiers, perched at the northern edge of the Chambolle-Musigny appellation in Burgundy's Côte de Nuits, presents a fascinating juxtaposition. Though Chambolle-Musigny wines are celebrated for their elegance and finesse, Les Sentiers' terroir leans towards the robust character found in neighboring Morey-Saint-Denis. This unique setting imparts a slightly more muscular profile to the Pinot Noir wines crafted here, offering a captivating blend of power and grace.

Les Sentiers means "the trails" in French, and refers to the paths that once ran through the vineyards.

Vinification: This wine was matured for 15 months in 2/3 new oak.

Grape varieties: Pinot Noir

Altitude: 260m to 270m ASL

Exposure: East

Soil: Clay mixed in with limestone soil
