Björnson Vineyard - Willamette Valley, Oregon

Björnson Vineyard, owned by Mark and Pattie Björnson since 2006, is located in the Eola-Amity Hills AVA of Oregon's Willamette Valley. They produce exceptional, sustainably grown wines, with a focus on Pinot Noir, Chardonnay, Auxerrois, and Grüner Veltliner. The 107-acre property features LIVE-certified vineyards, reflecting a dedication to environmental stewardship and careful site selection, resulting in expressive wines that capture the unique character of their volcanic soils and cool climate.



Golden Cluster - Portland, Oregon

Golden Cluster was founded in 2013 by Jeff Vejr, whose passion for old vines and innovative blending led him from collaborative projects in Europe to discovering Oregon's historic Semillon vines, which inspired him to stay and create wines that honor both heritage and exploration. The winery's name pays tribute to wine pioneer Charles Coury and to the Semillon grape, reflecting Vejr's respect for history and his commitment to producing unique wines from rare and old vine varieties.

Dodon Vineyards is a family-owned, sustainably-focused winery located in Maryland, dedicated to crafting high-quality estate-grown wines that reflect the unique terroir of their historic land.
