Cuvée Annamaria Clementi Riserva 2006 Franciacorta DOCG

92 pts.

"(100% Pinot Nero; spent eight years on its lees): Pale pink with a strong mousse. Ripe aromas of red cherry, raspberry liqueur and strawberry jelly are complemented by sweet oak, flowers and honey. Rich and almost sweet on entry, then creamy in the middle, with a sappy, palate-staining presence to its red fruit, floral and spice flavors. Much riper in style than the 2005 Annamaria Clementi, this fruit bomb coats the entire mouth and finishes creamy and long. The grapes for this wine grow in three of Ca' del Bosco's oldest Pinot Noir vineyards, with an average age of 29 years)." -lan D'Agata

Cuvée Annamaria Clementi Riserva Rosé 2005 Franciacorta DOCG

"(100% Pinot Nero): Bright pink with a steady stream of small bubbles. Sensational if youthfully subdued nose combines wild strawberry, raspberry, crushed stone, dried flowers and minerals. Wonderfully precise and taut in the mouth, with uncanny cut and energy for a Franciacorta wine; brisk acidity lifts and extends the intense red berry, nectarine and mineral flavors. Finishes with outstanding backbone and palate staining perfume. A world-class bubbly: the 2005 vintage doesn't get better than this in Franciacorta." -lan D'Agata
