| “Plenty of cherry and plum fruit is flanked by leather, tobacco and earth flavors. Balanced and bright, picking up hints of wild herbs on the lingering finish. Sangiovese and Merlot. Drink now through 2020. 8,100 cases made.” –BS | |
| Tolaini Valdisanti Toscana IGT 2011 | WS 91 pts |
| “Graphite and smoke aromas lead to black currant and blackberry fruit in this linear, firmly structured red. On the austere side, yet long and laserlike. Cabernet Sauvignon, Sangiovese and Cabernet Franc. Best from 2017 through 2027. 6,300 cases made.” –BS | |
| Tolaini Chianti Classico Gran Selezione DOCG 2011 | WS 92 pts |
| “Laced with balsamic aromas and juniper, sage, cherry, kirsch and tobacco flavors, this red is firm and complex. All the elements are present, but this needs time to come together. Fine length. Best from 2017 through 2024. 1,100 cases made.” –BS | |
