### **Terlaner I Grand Cuvée Alto Adige DOC 2012**

**97 points**

"An opulent white with sliced mangos, yogurt, cooked apples, mineral and pineapple. Full-bodied, bright and crisp. Subtle tropical fruits. Long and flavorful. A blend of mostly pinot bianco with touches of chardonnay and sauvignon. A wine from the best vineyards of one of the best white wine producers in Italy. Only 3,372 bottles made. " -J.S.

### **Ca' del Bosco Cuvée Annamaria Clementi Riserva Franciacorta DOCG 2006**

**96 points**

"A fabulous sparkling wine with super finesse and intensity. Very fine bead of bubble. Complex and subtle aromas of cooked apple, lemon, bread dough and light toffee. Full body, yet agile and bright. Dense and compacted palate. Aged some months on the lees. Clearly one of the great sparkling wines of the world." -J.S.

### **Giacomo Grimaldi Barolo Sotto Castello di Novello DOCG 2011**

**97 points**

"An opulent style of 2011 with dried fruit verging on prunes, dried flowers and licorice. Violets too. Full-bodied, chewy and very powerful. Long, long finish. Fruit and tar aftertaste. Great wine. Better in 2019." -J.S.
