"Bright straw. **Knockout Vermentino** aromas of pear, nectarine, fresh minty herbs and flint. At once dense and juicy, displaying sneaky concentration to the ripe, very precise flavors of orchard fruits and dried wildflowers. Finishes fresh and long, with repeating flint and floral notes. I can't remember the last time I had an entry-level Vermentino di Sardegna as good as this one." -Ian D'Agata



**90** pts.

"Bright medium-deep yellow. A hint of vanilla complements ripe yellow apple, fresh citrus fruits and anise on the nose. Rich, dense and very suave, with nectarine, honeyed peach and anise flavors along with a note of vanilla. Finishes tactile and long. The **Vermentino Stellato** is Pala's most important white wine and those who like a hint of sweet vanilla in their whites will love it; personally, I much prefer the very pure fruit delivery of their non-oaked Vermentino. "
