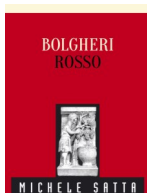
### Costa di Giulia Toscana IGT 2015

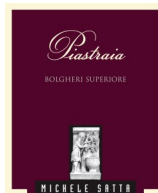
### Bolgheri Rosso DOC 2014
