HOME IS WHERE THE HEART IS

Chosen for the unique geology and climate conditions, Ridgeview established its home in 1995 at the foot of the South Downs National Park in Sussex. We were one of the first wineries in England to focus solely on the production of sparkling wines from Chardonnay, Pinot Noir and Pinot Meunier grape varieties. With meticulous attention to detail and expertise in cool climate viticulture, we are producing fruit of excellent ripeness and wonderful natural acidity - perfect for sparkling wine. In partnership with key growers in and around Southern England, we have substantially increased our production in line with global demand.



OUR WINERY

The family have been making wines at Ridgeview for 25 years focusing on exceptional quality from vine to glass. The philosophy in our winery is 'minimal intervention', while keeping control of the process and ensuring excellent quality in all that we do.

All grapes are handpicked and selected for perfect balance between ripeness, sugar and acidity. The grapes are then pressed in Ridgeview's modern winery and fermented in a combination of stainless-steel tanks and oak barrels.

Our winery is fully equipped with specialised sparkling wine production equipment and a purpose-built underground cellar where the wines can be stored in perfect conditions for secondary fermentation. To future proof our business we have recently added a new £2 million production facility which will enable us to sustainably cellar up to one million bottles underground.



Ridgeview welcomes visitors through our cellar door for tours and tastings seven days a week, all year round. We invite people from all over the world to celebrate with us for a range of occasions and events from Ridgefest to our guest chef 's dinner series to Easter trails.

We love nothing more than to host guests who want to kick back with a choice of carefully selected local produce and a glass of something delicious in our wine garden. From here you can drink in the breathtaking view from which we take our name.

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OUR

APPROACH TO PRODUCTION

One of the great advantages about growing grapes in the England is the cool climate, which give the grapes a natural and distinct acidity profile, totally unique to the England. The fruit then benefits from an extended period on the vine before it is harvested. This extended ripening increases the development of aromatics and flavour in each varietal, increasing it's charm and characteristics, making the fruit very concentrated.

At Ridgeview our aim is to harness and capture this advantageous viticulture and create a house style that reflects this - a style focused on wines with exceptional freshness, purity and expression of fruit.

The family have been making wine in the UK over two generations covering 25 years and have a unique depth of experience. We follow the traditional method of sparkling wine making to create finely balanced wines with exceptional texture and fine bubbles, each honed to communicate the distinctive character of England.

SIGNATURE RANGE

Our signature range represents the greatest introduction to our house style, with great emphasis on purity of fruit and freshness. Each style is crafted using a different blend of Chardonnay, Pinot Noir & Meunier from different parcels across a series of different vintages. Consistency, batch to batch is achieved through Simon, our Head Winemakers' skillful blending.



BLOOMSBURY NV

Chardonnay dominant, supported by Pinot Noir & Meunier. Ridgeview's signature wine follows the natural chardonnay dominant balance of the English harvest. The first wine ever made at Ridgeview, back in 1996. Chardonnay gives the wine its freshness & structure, it's bright citrus and crisp, green orchard fruits. The Pinots add delicate texture and a little extra roundness. Subtle honey and fresh baked bread notes hint at its cellar ageing. A fresh, fruit-forward, pioneering English style.

CAVENDISH NV

A third each of Pinot Noir, Pinot Meunier and Chardonnay. Ridgeview's 'traditional' style. Cavendish is a Pinot dominant blend. A bright, fresh wine packed full of redcurrant, blackberry and red apple fruit flavours. The style carries the signature Pinot gentle spice and earthy notes, contributing to it's complexity. Exceptionally balanced with great depth and roundness.

FITZROVIA NV

Ridgeview's signature Rosé. Chardonnay dominant, supported by Pinot Noir & Meunier. A bright, elegant, blended method Rosé. Incredibly pure and fruit driven. Fitzrovia showcases Chardonnay's fresh structure and citrus flavour and balances it with red berry fruit and a subtle fresh pastry note hinting at the cellar ageing. Very approachable, dry wine and a great example of the Ridgeview house style.

SIGNATURE RANGE

Our limited release range showcases the very best of what we do. Specific styles, made on a tiny scale from the very best parcels in the greatest vintages. These wines represent a focused vision of the fruit in a specific year. Increased lees ageing adds further complexity and depth, supporting the incredibly high-quality fruit.



BLANC DE NOIRS

Pinot Noir and Pinot Meunier only. Our fullest, most rounded style. This wine offers great depth and complexity. The intensity of flavour in the Pinots showcases the unique long ripening period. Across all our vineyards, each parcel of Pinot is hand-picked, pressed and fermented individually. Simon Roberts' favourite parcel will be blended to create a wine reflective of a unique vintage. Aged for a minimum of three years on lees.


ROSÉ DE NOIRS

RIDGEVIEW

Pinot Noir & Meunier. Saignée method Rosé. This wine is a real winemaker's wine. Produced only in the best vintages when the Pinots are at their best. Incredibly delicate and elegant style achieved through short maceration in contact with skins. Miniscule parcels are released following a minimum of three years of lees. Exceptional roundness and beautifully balanced fruit.

BLANC DE BLANCS

100% Chardonnay, from a single vineyard. Our flagship wine. Made in very limited quantities from grapes grown in our original two-hectare vineyard, on site at the estate in Ditchling. 25 year old vines (some of the oldest Chardonnay vines in England) produce highly concentrated, pure fruit. Aged for a minimum of three years on lees before release, this style shows the very best of Chardonnay in the UK. Pure, precise and finely structured.
