André Hueston Mack, founder of Maison Noir Wines and In Sheep's Clothing, is a pioneering winemaker who blends street culture with classic traditions to create bold, authentic, and approachable wines.

The name is a hat tip to Alonzo Harris (*Training Day*): "To protect the sheep you gotta catch the wolf, and it takes a wolf to catch a wolf."

Crisp and refreshing, the In Sheep's Clothing Pinot Grigio showcases aromas of green apple, pear, and lemon zest, with subtle hints of white flowers and wet stone. On the palate, it is bright and lively, featuring flavors of ripe peach, Meyer lemon, and a touch of honeysuckle, balanced by a clean minerality and a mouthwatering acidity.
