



CHÂTEAU DOMPIERRE HAUT-MÉDOC LA CROIX DE DOMPIERRE



Château Dompierre, created in 2013 by Michel Aroldi, represents a new venture in the heart of Bordeaux's traditional Left Bank. The estate departs from Bordeaux convention by adopting a Burgundian mindset—focusing on precision, terroir expression, and restrained winemaking. In a short period, Dompierre has gained recognition for crafting wines of individuality and finesse.

Michel Aroldi's winemaking technique, aimed at imparting finesse and elegance to the wine becomes even more crucial when the terroir in question proves to be powerful. The vineyard is located north of Saint-Estephe, and the wine emerges as a perfect example of a Haut-Medoc whose silky tannins resemble velvet.
