Passopisciaro, founded by Andrea Franchetti on Etna's north slope, is known for its old-vine Nerello Mascalese and some of Chardonnay. The estate's wines emphasize clarity, minerality, and finesse to highlight volcanic character. Now led by Benjamin Franchetti, Passopisciaro continues to produce elegant, site-focused wines that have shaped modern perceptions of Etna.

A distinctive Chardonnay from vineyards planted at an impressive 900-1,000 meters above sea level on ash-rich volcanic soils. The wine shows layered aromas of honey, toasted almond, saffron and Sicilian orange, carried by a supple, waxy mid-weight palate. Polished and expressive, with real charm.
