Passopisciaro, founded by Andrea Franchetti on Etna's north slope, is known for its old-vine Nerello Mascalese and some of Chardonnay. The estate's wines emphasize clarity, minerality, and finesse to highlight volcanic character. Now led by Benjamin Franchetti, Passopisciaro continues to produce elegant, site-focused wines that have shaped modern perceptions of Etna.

Scinniri is a complex wine, with notes of dark ripe fruit, black cherry, blackberry, and plums going hand in hand with dried flowers and Mediterranean aromatic herbs. Long sip, freshness, and minerality from Nerello Mascalese, the wine is uplifting and at the same time very quaffable. The long aging softened the tannins, cherishing the palate and making it elegant.
