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The name Subsoil refers to the sediment deposited in the Columbia Basin by the Missoula Floods, a cataclysm about 18,000 years ago that shaped today's wine regions in the Pacific Northwest. And yes, this lovely cabernet sauvignon has deep flavors of dark cherry, plum and berries, with soft tannins embracing the finish. Great for steaks, roasts and stews.
