

Domaine Doudet

Corton-Maréchaudes Rouge Grand Cru





The only red Grand Cru of the Côte de Beaune. The vineyard is located between two villages: Ladoix and Aloxe-Corton. Doudet's Corton Maréchaudes is an old vineyard of about one hectare just below "Les Bressandes", near the village of Ladoix-Serrigny.

Vinification: Hand harvest. Temperature-controlled fermentation. Maturation in oak barrels for 18 months with 20% new oak barrels.

Grape varieties: Pinot Noir

Vineyard age: 65-year-old vines

Soil: Clayey and calcareous soil

Tasting notes:

An expressive nose of red fruits and fine spices. The palate is lively and wild. Blackcurrant, gooseberry, blackberry and cherry. Powerful and subtle.
