Napa Estate Eastern Exposure Zinfandel





This special barrel selection is presented to showcase just how elegant, fragrant, and balanced Napa hillside Zinfandels can be. Occupying a mountainside at the head of the Napa Valley, Zinfandels were first planted here in 1883. It is a grape unusually well adapted to the red clay loam soils, eastern exposures, and microclimate of Storybook's hillside estate. The vines are hand tended, from pruning through picking. Storybook is a CCOF-certified organic grower.

Cooperage: 14 months in French and American oak.

Grape varieties: Zinfandel Press Notes

Exposure: Eastern Wine & Spirits

Soil: Red clay loam soils 2019 92 points

Alcohol: 14.5%

Tasting notes:

Berries with hints of flowers, minerals, and spice in the aroma; multi-layered and rich flavor on the broad and supple middle palate; and an intense, clean, and lingering impression on the finish.



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
