

San Salvatore 1988

Vetere IGP Paestum Rosato



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This wine takes its name from Magliano Vetere, a small town in the Cilento National Park near San Salvatore's Cannito vineyards where the organic grapes used to make this wine are grown.

Vinification: 6 hours of cryomaceration. Soft pressing with brief skin contact followed by fermentation in stainless steel tanks.

Aging: stainless steel tanks on the lees for 6 months before release.
