

## Sokol Blosser

## Kalita Vineyard Yamhill-Carlton Estate Pinot Noir





Kalita Estate Vineyard is located in the heart of the Yamhill-Carlton AVA in the Willamette Valley. This stunning, bowl-shaped vineyard was planted in 2000 by Arthur and Sherry Kalita; it is currently LIVE certified, and Sokol Blosser is transitioning the vineyard to organic certification.

The fruit was hand-harvested from Kalita Vineyard and brought back to the Sokol Blosser Dundee Hills Estate winery where 96% was destemmed and the rest left wholecluster. The destemmed fruit went through an ambient fermentation while the whole cluster was fermented using our native house yeast. All of this took place in three-ton stainless steel tanks with punchdowns for cap management. The wine was aged for 10 months in French oak barrels with 20% new oak.

Grape varieties: 100% Pinot Noir

Vineyard age: Planted from 1999 - 2001

Alcohol: 14.5%

Tasting notes:

An abundance of black fruit with blackberry, black currants, and black cherry with fresh blossom. A big, rich Pinot Noir with a perfect balance between fruit and tannins. Pair with roasted chicken, beet and goat cheese salad, or a seared rack of lamb with morels.
