Vineyards: Grapes for this Pinot Noir were sourced from premium vineyards within the Santa Lucia Highlands in Monterey.

Renowned winemaker, Jim Milone, crafts, blends and bottles Matthew Fritz in Healdsburg, Sonoma County. Jim grew up in the vineyards of his grandfather's winery in Mendocino County and currently lives in Northern Sonoma. His excellent relationships with wineries and growers throughout California are invaluable to our vineyard sourcing.

Aging: 6 months in French oak

Grape varieties: Pinot Noir

Alcohol: 13.5%

Tasting notes:

The wine is a medium ruby with aromas of violets, clove, and fresh dark cherries. The palate is elegant, textured and filled with ripe raspberry and cherry flavors with hints of mushroom and black tea. The finish has mouthwatering acidity and medium tannin.
