Throughout his career Andre Mack has forged unique relationships with luminary growers and winemakers from around the planet. It is with this prestigious group that Mack currently creates his wines. The name is a hat tip to Alonzo Harris (Training Day): "to protect the sheep you gotta catch the wolf, and it takes a wolf to catch a wolf."

Vinification: The grapes are harvested from a variety of vineyard sites in Oregon. Fermentation and maturation is all in stainless steel.

Grape varieties: Pinot Grigio

Alcohol: 13.5%

Tasting notes:

Crisp and refreshing, the In Sheep's Clothing Pinot Grigio showcases aromas of green apple, pear, and lemon zest, with subtle hints of white flowers and wet stone. On the palate, it is bright and lively, featuring flavors of ripe peach, Meyer lemon, and a touch of honeysuckle, balanced by a clean minerality and a mouthwatering acidity.
