Founded by vintner and entrepreneur Matthew Bonanno, Matthew Fritz is the companion wines to his Napa Valley flagship, BonAnno Cabernet Sauvignon. Matthew Fritz was founded on a few simple principles; seek out and source from top North Coast vineyards, let the fruit stand on its own through a pure, clean winemaking process, and ultimately, ensure every bottle of Matthew Fritz is a true representation of both the variety and appellation.

Vineyards: Sourced from select vineyard sites in Red Hills, Lake County—an AVA known for volcanic soils, high elevation, and naturally structured Cabernet Sauvignon.

Aging: 14 months in French oak

Grape varieties : 100% Cabernet Sauvignon

Soil : Volcanic

Alcohol : 14.1%

This is a bold, polished red with generous layers of dark cherry and blackberry, accented by notes of cedar and subtle herbs. The palate is rich and structured, with firm tannins, fresh acidity, and a smooth, balanced finish that keeps the wine both powerful and easy to enjoy.
