Michel Aroldi's winemaking technique, aimed at imparting finesse and elegance to the wine becomes even more crucial when the terroir in question proves to be powerful. The vineyard is located north of Saint-Estephe, and the wine emerges as a perfect example of a Haut-Medoc whose silky tannins resemble velvet.

Vineyard Location: Saint-Seurin-de-Cadourne

Vinification and Aging:

- -Sustainable agriculture
- -Plowing, leaf removal & green harvests
- -Spontaneous fermentation in large wooden vats
- -5 weeks maceration
- -Fermentation with caps fully submerged
- -24 months aging in wooden vats

Grape varieties: 85% Cabernet Sauvignon, 15% Merlot

Soil: Gravel, sand, clay & marl

Alcohol: 14%
