## Dompierre Pauillac





Château Dompierre's Pauillac is the estate's flagship red cuvée, a wine that boldly marries the power of Médoc terroir with Burgundian finesse. Crafted from a meticulously maintained 2.5?hectare vineyard on the coveted plateau of Saint?Lambert (near Château Latour), this expression is composed entirely of 100% Cabernet Sauvignon and yields just around 11,000 bottles annually. The result is a wine that defies traditional Bordeaux, delivering exceptional fruit purity, velvety sweetness, and an extraordinary balance of power and tannic finesse.

Vineyard Location: Plateau of Saint-Lambert

Vinification and Aging:

- -Sustainable agriculture
- -Plowing, leaf removal & green harvests
- -Spontaneous fermentation in large wooden vats
- -8 weeks maceration
- -Fermentation with caps fully submerged
- -36 months aging in wooden vats

Grape varieties: 100% Cabernet Sauvignon

Soil: Gravel, sand, clay, limestone & marl.

Alcohol: 14%
