*Let's Be Fronk Cabernet Franc Willamette Valley*



The fruit for this wine is sourced from several of the finest vineyards in the Willamette

Valley; it is this combination of grapes from a variety of appellations that creates a wine that is broad and complex with many layers.

The grapes used to make this wine are sourced from the Eola Springs Vineyard in the Eola-Amity Hills AVA.

Vintage Notes: The 2025 vintage began with a cool, wet spring that delayed budbreak, followed by a warm, dry growing season and an early harvest. The resulting wines show vibrant freshness, balanced ripeness, and exceptional concentration.

Grape varieties : 100% Cabernet Franc

Soil : Marine sedimentary soils

Alcohol : 13.2%

Acidity : 5.9 g/L

Residual Sugar : 0 g/L

Black cherry, raspberry, a little cracked pepper, and fresh herbs, all wrapped up in a bright, juicy package. Works well with a little chill on the bottle. Fresh and energetic!
