The fruit for this wine is sourced from several of the finest vineyards in the Willamette Valley; it is this combination of grapes from a variety of appellations that creates a wine that is broad and complex with many layers.

The grapes used to make this wine are sourced from the Eola Springs Vineyard in the Eola-Amity Hills AVA.

Vintage Notes: The 2025 vintage began with a cool, wet spring that delayed budbreak, followed by a warm, dry growing season and an early harvest. The resulting wines show vibrant freshness, balanced ripeness, and exceptional concentration.

Grape varieties : 100% Mencia

Soil : Marine sedimentary soils

Alcohol : 12.7%

Residual Sugar : 0 g/L

Tasting notes :

100% Mencia with an Oregon accent -bright, lifted, and full of energy. Layers of cherry, raspberry, wild herbs, and subtle earth lead to a long, savory finish that's made for anything kissed by fire.
