

## Domaine des Coltabards

## Sancerre





Domaine des Coltabards is located in the Ménétréol region of the Loire Valley. The grapes are grown on Kimmeridgian soils, which helps to impart a distinct minerality to this wine.

The grapes are hand harvested, carefully selected and then crushed. Cold settling, with fermentation starting at low temperatures in temperature-controlled stainless steel tanks.

The wine is aged on the lees until bottling to preserve freshness and filtered once prior to bottling.

Grape varieties: Sauvignon Blanc

Altitude: 320m ASL

Exposure: Southeast

Soil: Terre Blanche (Kimmeridgian clay),

limestone

Alcohol: 12.5%

## Tasting notes:

Vibrant floral aromas (white flowers) and fruit (grapefruit, orange) on the nose. The palate is round and well-balanced with remarkable length and freshness on the finish.
