This particular Meursault comes from two vineyards considered among the best of the Village climats: Le Limozin (located near Meursault 1st Cru Genevrières) and Vireuils (Higher up on the slope, more towards Auxey-Duresses). This wine is vinified in 20% new oak.

Grape varieties : Chardonnay

Altitude : 150m-250m

Vineyard age : 30 to 50 year old vines

Grape yield : 55 hl/ha

Exposure : Southeast

Soil : Limestone, Clay

Alcohol : 13%
