Beaujolais-Villages



Gérard Brisson's Beaujolais-Villages parcel is located in the the village of Régnié. The grapes are all harvested by hand and then crushed in whole bunches. A cold maceration takes place to concentrate the fruit before the temperature-controlled fermentation.

Grape varieties : Gamay

Altitude : 150-200m

Vineyard age : 50 years old

Grape yield : 50 hl/ha

Exposure : South-southeast

Soil : Sand, Granite

Alcohol : 12.5%

Tasting notes :

A very harmonious wine with aromas of violet on the nose. Elements of strawberry and soft fine tannins on the palate. Delicious as an aperitif with charcuterie. Also an ideal accompaniment to fish dishes.
