The grapes are hand harvested and undergo a semi-carbonic maceration. There is no destemming and the wine ages in stainless steel and concrete for 12 months prior to bottling.

Grape varieties : Gamay

Altitude : 320m ASL

Vineyard age : 50-60 year old vines.

Grape yield : 45hl/hc

Exposure : South-southeast

Soil : Granite

Alcohol : 12.5%

Flavors of strawberry and red currant with firm, integrated tannins. An ideal pairing with roasted meats, sauteed vegetables and pungent cheeses.
