Gevey Chambertin village made from grapes grown in three different parcels. (2 in 'Les Seuvrees' and 1 in 'En Deree'). Sebastien makes an average of 12 barrels every vintage. The wine spends one year in third-use barrels.

Grape varieties : Pinot Noir

Altitude : 250m - 350m ASL

Vineyard age : Planted in 1980.

Exposure : East/South-East

Soil : Brown limestone soil and stoney in some areas

Tasting notes :

A fruity, slightly spicy wine with soft tannins. Good aging potential of up to 15 years.
