

Domaine Odoul-Coquard

Gevrey-Chambertin



A Gevrey-Chambertin village-level wine made from grapes grown in three different parcels. (two in 'Les Seuvrees' and one in 'En Deree'). Sebastien makes an average of 12 barrels every vintage. The wine spends one year in third-use barrels.

Grape varieties : Pinot Noir

Altitude : 250m - 350m ASL

Vineyard age : Planted in 1980.

Exposure : East/South-East

Soil : Brown limestone soil and stoney in some areas

Tasting notes :

A fruity, slightly spicy wine with soft tannins. Good aging potential of up to 15 years.
