Made from two parcels planted to 60 and 70-year-old vines. Matured 15 months in oak barrels (60% new barrels).

Grape varieties : Pinot Noir

Altitude : 260m - 280m ASL

Vineyard age : 60 to 70-year-old vines

Exposure : East

Soil : Sandy soil, little chalky rocks

Tasting notes :

Elegant, soft, fruity, and very feminine with smooth, subtle tannins and complex aromas. Great aging capacity with white and red meats and cheeses.
