

## Ca' Viola

### *Brichet Barbera d'Alba DOC*



Almost 2.4 hectares of 20 years old vines nestled on Montelupo hills at 400 meters of height. The results are reflected in a wine of tradition that expresses with great elegance the main features of one of the most important Piemontese varieties. The wine spends 15-18 days in temperature-controlled tanks with 12 months in big barrels.

Grape varieties : Barbera

Altitude : 400m ASL

Vineyard age : 20 years old

Grape yield : 70 q/ha

Exposure : South, Southwest

Soil : Calcareous marl and clay

Alcohol : 14%
