Paradiesgarten Riesling Kabinett



The Paradiesgarten vineyard is situated on the western slope of Deidesheim next to a forested hill. The name was given to this vineyard because it truly feels like Paradise here. The grapes are hand harvested and spontaneous fermentation takes place in stainless steel tanks. The wine rests on the lees for 7 months until it is bottled in the spring after harvest and released a few months later.
