


Terlano

Altitude: 400-900 m ASL

Exposure: South/Southwest

Soil: Sandy clay and porphyric soil

Alcohol: 13.5%

This Müller-Thurgau is pale yellow in appearance with a light aromatic bouquet of tropical fruit. Dry and medium-bodied on the palate with flavors of mango and peach balanced by crisp acidity.
