Cabernet Sauvignon Lazy Susan Ranch





LSR Lazy Susan Ranch Cabernet Sauvignon takes the original name of our historic property. Lazy Susan Ranch is 100% Cabernet sourced from the estate's younger vines. The wine expresses all of the signatures of the estate's Diamond Mountain terrior and shows the minerality of its red Aiken iron-rich soils. Production is extremely limited, not exceeding 100- 200 cases per year depending on the selection and vintage.

Grape varieties: Cabernet Sauvignon

Altitude: 800m A.S.L.

Vineyard age: 7 years old

Grape yield: 2 tons per acre

Exposure: South

Soil: Red Aiken iron-rich

Tasting notes:

The wine is full-bodied, lush and dense showcasing a smooth velvet texture. Red and black cassis dominate the palate with dusty tannins.
