Pernand-Vergelesses 1er Cru Sous Frétille Blanc



Pernand-Vergelesses is tucked into the junction of two valleys among the hills of the Côte de Beaune. The nearby Hill of Corton stands guard over it and two other villages, Aloxe-Corton and Ladoix-Serrigny, harboring prestigious Grands Crus: Corton in red and Corton-Charlemagne in white.

Fermentation takes place in temperature-controlled vats followed by aging in French oak barrels of 228 litres.

Grape varieties : Chardonnay

Vineyard age : 50-year-old vines

Exposure : South-East

Soil : Clay and Limestone

Alcohol : 13.5%

Tasting notes :

On the palate, a mineral wine with flavors of white flowers that combine subtlety and freshness. Long finish.
