Comprised primarily of a handful of exceptional Grand Cru and Premier Cru vineyards in the Côte de Beaune, including its namesake monopole, the top priority at Clos de la Chapelle is to facilitate the purest expression possible of each parcel's terroir. Nearly 150 years ago, Victor Boillot created this beautiful small domaine with its three 1er Cru parcels, which was subsequently inherited by Louis Boillot, the last member of his family to own the property. Mark O'Connell purchased this historic property in 2011, along with his business partners, Philippe Remoissent and Pierre Meurgey, and they rechristened it in honor of its flagship monopole as the Domaine Clos de la Chapelle. Together with technical director Coralie Allexant-Manière and vineyard manager Frédéric Gaillard, the entire team shares the vision of organic viticulture and biodynamic practices with the goal of producing the best expression of terroir inherent in each tiny parcel. The total production for all vineyards combined is about 1800 cases in an average year. Mark's passion for this project and commitment to the highest quality wines is unending.
