

Demerara Cask Rum 2002







From the producer:

"How intriguing, how fascinating to see the impact of the production process itself. How wonderful to discover the various states of evolution that Guyana rums go through before they reach the extensive aging phase. Three little brothers of the late nineties and the beginning of the new millennium. More precisely 1998, 2001 and 2002, who will keep us company this year. An exciting opportunity for you, our valued customers, to see just how much the product changes in the barrel. Of course, the scents and flavours are similar, since they come from the same stock - you'll enjoy seeing how their characteristics evolve, we're sure. Here we are sampling the youngest."

This rum hails from British Guyana, located in the north coast of South America. 14 years in cask in Scotland produces a rum of great layered complexity and intrigue.

Tasting Notes:

A pungent and unusual bouquet of thyme, juniper, tobacco, shiny leather. Reminiscent of an antique shop, perhaps. In the mouth it's agile, fast, aggressive - characteristic of its youth - and sweet, buttery scents alternate with woody, toasted hints of a slightly acerbic tannin.
