


## Prichard's Distillery

TASTING NOTES by Frederick Koeppel, Memphis Commercial Appeal

An immediate impression of toffee and cream with hints of orange, apricot and cloves and a back note of bananas. It's extremely palatable and full-bodied, with a smooth, chewy texture, touches of cloves and cinnamon, though it's not too sweet and it has a long dry finish.

PHIL'S PREFERRED COCKTAIL: Served neat in a brandy snifter next to the fireplace with a good book.
