From the producer:

"The golden age of the Caribbean... the eighteenth century when the galleons from Old Europe brought adventurers, impoverished aristocrats, desperados, bandits and benefactors. All in search of a second chance, a new destiny. Trinidad, from Columbus onwards (the explorer discovered the island on his third voyage), certainly saw it all, receiving - or in some cases stealing - something from every one of these many souls."

Tasting Notes:

Mossy, earthy aromas, like a choir at the back of the nave. The flavours feel remote, preceded by an instant softness, as vanilla, licorice, nuts and dried fruits mingle with notes of fruity freshness. This is a complex rum, shall we say, a rum that teases. A taste explosion of myrtle, juniper berry and a buttery sweetness of pollen. Flavours rounded and softened, almost brought to life. Chlorophyll tones provide structure.
