Champagne Goutorbe-Bouillot

Clos des Monnaies Extra-Brut

The Clos des Monnaies was first planted by Jules Goutorbe in 1930 and is one of only 25 walled vineyards in Champagne. It is .28 ha in size. Fermentation and aging in neutral oak barrels. After 50 months on the lees, the wine is disgorged and the wine rests for a year in bottle before release.



Grape varieties 50% Pinot Meunier and 50% Chardonnay

Tasting notes

A fresh and complex nose, with notes of flowers and patisserie evolving towards hints of tea. Gentle at first, the palate is round and rich. The finesse of the Chardonnay appears in mid-palate and gives the wine a long refreshing finish



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
